Experience painting along the beautiful Cache La Poudre River, one of the only remaining “Wild and Scenic” rivers in the Continental United States. This majestic river runs through red rock and granite canyons, and meadows into ponds in the foot hills of the Rocky Mountains. You will learn the plein air “painting in layers” method. It is all about value and color. First you will learn how to quickly build a composition with depth and values in acrylic, then apply the final layers in oil, to bring in relevant detail, subtle light effects and color to create sparkling paintings. Personal style and expression are encouraged. The painting in layers method will enable you to get beyond the minutia and put down on canvas your impressions of the visual landscape. There will be individual instruction at your easel, Demos, lectures, and critiques.

Dates and Times:

The workshop will begin with an instructional lecture and orientation on Friday the 5th of July from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm at the Cocoa Gallery in Old Town Fort Collins . We will be painting from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm on the 6th and 7th. Each day we will do two locations, one in the morning and one in the afternoon and we will wrap up with a critique.
